## **NOTICE OF DECISION**

**ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited**

**THE ELECTRICITY WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2017**

Notice is hereby given that ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited (“the Company”) has been granted consent by Scottish Ministers to construct and operate the Arecleoch Windfarm Extension, an electricity generating station with a generating capacity exceeding 50 MW, comprising of 13 turbines with a maximum height to blade tip of up to 200 metres, located approximately 3 km south of Barrhill in the Planning authority area of South Ayrshire Council and Dumfries & Galloway Council.

Scottish Ministers have also directed, under section 57 (2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be granted for the proposed Development.
