

NOTICE OF DECISION
ELECTRICITY ACT 1989
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997
THE ELECTRICITY WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT
ASSESSMENT)(SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2017

As directed by regulation 23(4) of the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) 2017, notice is hereby given that ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited (“the Company”) has been **refused** consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 by the Scottish Ministers to construct and operate the Clauchrie Wind Farm, a proposed wind powered electricity generating station comprising of 18 wind turbines with a ground to blade tip height of up to 200 metres (“m”), an electricity storage facility and associated ancillary development, with an electricity generation capacity in excess of 50 megawatts (the “proposed Development”). The proposed Development was to be located approximately 5.5 km north-east of Barrhill in South Ayrshire Council planning area.
