Appendix 7.6 Ferry Route Wireframes


This appendix includes a set of sequential wireframes and photographs to aid the assessment from these route receptors. Each wireframe and photograph illustrates a 40 degree included angle, as taken with a fixed 50mm camera lens taken at regular intervals. Due to the difficulty of producing photomontage visualisations from moving ferries, a single frame photomontage from the two key routes is included.

Due to the speed of ferries and difficulty in precise alignments the photographs may not always line up with the wireframes and accuracy is approximate. They are there to provide context only. Due to the variability of weather conditions, tides and operational requirements ferries do not always take the exact same route and wireframe locations on the plans match the route the ferry took on the day of the assessment and when photographs were taken.

Some routes may also be represented by Viewpoints within the assessment, where this is the case the Viewpoints are noted.


Ferry route between Portavadie and Tarbert, Kintyre


There would be no visibility at the Tarbert ferry terminal. **Viewpoint 5** is representative of view at the ferry terminal at Portavadie.




Point C: SINGLE FRAME PHOTOMONTAGE - Portavadie to Tarbert

1.1 Ferry route between Lochranza, Arran and Claonaig, Kintyre








Point F: SINGLE FRAME PHOTOMONTAGE - Lochranza to Claonaig Ferry

1.2 Ferry route between Lochranza, Arran and Tarbert, Kintyre




