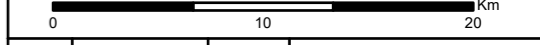

The ZTV is calculated to individual turbine blade tip height (180 m) from a viewing height of 2 m above ground level. The terrain model assumes bare ground and is derived from OS Terrain 50 data (obtained from Emapsite 2024). Earth curvature and atmospheric refraction have been taken into account. The ZTV was calculated using ArcPro 3.3.1.
